It is also imperative that the address you have given us is the address you would like your certificate sent to. Please check your contact details on 'My Account/My Contact Details' and update if you have moved house or relocated. For the November External Moderation **3% of certificates** were returned by Royal Mail and there is a £5.00 charge to get them re-posted to you.

COURSE UPDATE

Further to the Access to Childhood Studies, Construction and Business Diplomas launched in September 2016, we also launched a new option for both the **Midwifery** and the **Nursing career pathways**, which again is proving to be an extremely popular course.

Since its launch in September we already have over 250 learners working towards their diploma.

Access to Higher Education Diploma to Nursing and Midwifery (NM)

Online Access to Higher Education Diploma Nursing and Midwifery (NM) is a new course where learners undertake 45 graded credits in Biology, Social Issues in Healthcare and Psychology with 15 ungraded credits. The course, as with most of our other Access to HE Diploma courses, is available in 2 forms **Option 1** where you brush up your English and Maths skills in some ungraded Level Two units or **Option 2** where you study all ungraded units at Level Three.
