November Moderation



Well done to our students who have completed their course for November moderation!

If this is you there are a few things to do to ensure that we can keep you updated and the processes up to you receiving your certificate run smoothly:

- 1. Please complete and upload a course evaluation form.
- 2. Please read the How to Guide on certification.
- 3. Email exams@distancelearningcentre.com you only need to say Hi but just sending this email means that communications regarding moderation from the exams office are less likely to go into your junk mail
- 4. Check your name and address are correct on your learner account (as these will be used for writing / posting your certificate)

Certificates will be sent to us by the Awarding Body some time in January 2023 - the exams office will keep you updated on moderation and certification.

UCAS

If you are applying to university for 2023, we strongly advise you complete your UCAS

application as soon as possible, remember to use the advice on the UCAS application page in your learner account toolkit.

University of Sunderland Online Class- Paramedicine

On **Wednesday 9th Novermber at 7PM** we will have a special guest on our online class!

Mark Willis, who is the programme lead for Paramedic Science at the University of Sunderland, will be hosting an online class with us talking about their Paramedicine course, making this a great opportunity to have your questions answered!

The university has two intakes of 80 places for Paramedic Science a year - one in September and another in May. The May intake is less competitive (as A Level students are not able to apply for these places). They are recruiting now for May 2023, so if you are moderating in November and looking for a paramedicine course, this may be particularly useful and interesting to you as you could start your course much earlier!

Your questions answered



We are introducing a new regular feature to the newsletter where we will answer frequently asked questions from students. This month's question is:

Why do we ask you for you to complete 6 credits of work and the tutor UCAS ref form before we issue the Buzzword for UCAS?

Our answer:

By giving you the UCAS Buzzword we are agreeing for you to link your application to us – and that we will provide a reference for you. Unless you have completed 6 credits of work it would be very difficult for us to provide any information to the universities about how you are doing academically – this is the minimum amount of work (usually the first two units) we need to be able to do this. We ask you to complete the Tutor UCAS Reference form to double check your intended university choices and provide us with any other information which we may not know about you (such as your work experience) so that we can comment on this in your reference.

Whilst you can apply for UCAS independently it is worthwhile linking your application to us as we check your application and write your reference (and share this with you) before it is sent to the universities.
